Our allocation for Pupil Premium 2014-2015 was £133,100

2014-15 Spending of the Pupil Premium allocation included:

- Reading Recovery Teacher
- Better Reading Partnership
- Family Liaison Co-ordinator support for families
- Nurture Leader employed to provide 1-1 support, social skills groups, lunchtime activities etc. for vulnerable children
- Play Therapist employed to provide 1-1 Play Therapy sessions
- Eden Counselling
- Subsidising the cost of activities for identified children
- Access to outside agencies, e.g. Educational Psychologist

KS2 Progress

Progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 for pupils who are Pupil Premium eligible indicates that the children made good progress overall.

Phonics Screening

Year 1 - 80% (12/15) of the pupils who are Pupil Premium eligible passed the Statutory Phonics Screening Check compared to the National 2014 Average of 63%.

Year 2 - of the pupils who had to retake the Statutory Phonics Screening Check, 50% (1/2) of the pupils who are Pupil Premium eligible passed compared with the National 2014 Average of 60%.

2015-16 Pupil Premium Allocation is likely to be **£120,000**.
